## Chapter 1

# A Sacred Call

*The word of the LORD came to me, saying, "Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, before you were born I set you apart; I appointed you as a prophet to the nations." "Ah, Sovereign LORD," I said, "I do not know how to speak; I am only a child." But the LORD said to me, "Do not say, I am only a child." You must go to everyone I send you to and say whatever I command you. Do not be afraid of them, for I am with you and will rescue you, ' declares the LORD. **Then the LORD reached out his hand and touched my mouth and said to me, "Now, I have put my words in your mouth. See, today I appoint you over nations and kingdoms to uproot and tear down, to destroy and overthrow, to build and to plant."***

*Jeremiah 1:4-10, NIV*

As God spoke these words to his future prophet, Jeremiah, He was preparing the prophet for a tremendous calling—a calling to stand before people who had the power to do him harm.

The calling of a prophet is never easy—it's never a bed of roses, so to speak.

The calling of a prophet is simple: he or she speaks the word of God. As God speaks, the prophet is responsible to hear what God is saying and repeat it faithfully.

In other places, I have described the calling of the prophet much as the calling of a good interpreter at a foreign rally.

As a minister speaks, audiences who do not speak English have no way of understanding what

the minister is saying—he could be saying anything, as far as they're concerned.

But if the minister has a good interpreter—like Argimero Figuero was for me for so many years—the people in the audience get exactly the sermon the preacher is preaching.

Good interpreters even take on the mannerisms of the preacher, gesturing at the same time in the same manner, inflecting the same words, etc.

But a bad interpreter can be a nightmare.

There's an old joke that goes like this:

An American businessman was hired by a Japanese company to share with them a certain business technique they wanted to use.

As he got up to teach the Japanese, he began with a joke—the same joke he had used in other presentations all over the world.

When he had finished the joke, the crowd laughed riotously, much more vehemently than any other crowd had laughed at the joke.

After the meeting, one of the businessman's associates went to the interpreter and asked him why the people had laughed so long and hard at what had been a second-class joke at best.

"It's simple," the interpreter said. "I told them, 'Americans feel the need to open business speeches with jokes. It's impolite to not laugh at their humor. OK. Here comes the punch line. Now! Laugh like he said something really funny.'"

That's a rather benign example of an interpreter who does not faithfully communicate the message being spoken by the person speaking.

But the point is, God requires an accurate interpreter—He requires His prophets to faithfully



represent what He is saying to the people He's intending to say it to.

Unfortunately for the prophets, that can sometimes lead to trouble as the people being spoken to do not take kindly to the divine message.

There were so few prophets during the Old Testament times because the job was dangerous and difficult—and God could not find very many who would faithfully do the job.

Even when He found a man as righteous as Jeremiah, God first assured him that his prophesying would not lead to his death—God would protect him from the powerful people to whom he would be prophesying.

That's important, because it automatically denotes that the things Jeremiah would have to say to them would not always be pleasant.

There was a movement a few years ago that stressed that New Testament prophecy is always positive.

Those who subscribed to such nonsense obviously never looked at the book of Revelation, and never read of Peter's prophecy to Ananias and Sapphira:

*Now a man named Ananias, together with his wife Sapphira, also sold a piece of property. With his wife's full knowledge he kept back part of the money for himself, but brought the rest and put it at the apostles' feet. Then Peter said, "Ananias, how is it that Satan has so filled your heart that you have lied to the Holy Spirit and have kept for yourself some of the money you received for the land? Didn't it belong to you before it was sold? And after it was sold, wasn't the money at your disposal? What made you think of doing such a thing? You have not lied to men but to God." When Ananias heard this,*

*he fell down and died. And great fear seized all who heard what had happened. Then the young men came forward, wrapped up his body, and carried him out and buried him. About three hours later his wife came in, not knowing what had happened. Peter asked her, "Tell me, is this the price you and Ananias got for the land?" "Yes," she said, "that is the price." Peter said to her, "How could you agree to test the Spirit of the Lord? **Look! The feet of the men who buried your husband are at the door, and they will carry you out also.**" At that moment she fell down at his feet and died. Then the young men came in and, finding her dead, carried her out and buried her beside her husband. Great fear seized the whole church and all who heard about these events.*

*Acts 5:1-11 NIV*

That's a pretty negative prophecy, partner.

Everyone's stated desire in the Church is almost always the same: I just want to know how to get God to move in my life.

Everyone wants God to move in their lives, but not everyone is willing to let Him do exactly as He wants to do.

Pay attention to this, because it's a fundamental truth that will revolutionize your life.

If you want God to move in your life, you must be willing to do things that seem distasteful to you—things that could get you in trouble, things that could even get you killed.

Everyone wants God to move in their lives—AS LONG AS HE MOVES IN THE MANNER **THEY WANT HIM TO MOVE!**

Oh, partner, read that again.

Everyone wants God to move in healing...

Everyone wants God to move in deliverance...

Everyone wants God to move in financial blessing...

Everyone wants God to move in tremendous revelations...

Everyone wants God to move in powerful manifestations of the Spirit...

That's a universal desire, partner.

As long as God will behave, everyone wants Him to move in their lives.

But not everyone wants God to just be God!

What if God wants to move in your life in being quiet and just meditating on Him?

Would you still be willing?

Even if nobody ever knew of that quiet, special time and thought within themselves that you were just a lazy Christian who never did any good?

What if God asked you to do something completely humiliating? What if His move in you was something that would never be obvious to anyone else—something that would be just between you and Him? No healing, no deliverance, no financial blessing, no tremendous revelation, no powerful manifestation of the Spirit—just a quiet time meditating on Him?

Do you still want Him to move in your life?

No matter what you answer to these questions, God knows your heart—just as He professed to know Jeremiah before the prophet was even born.

If you want God to move in your life, you must be willing to let Him move as He wants to move—no matter what that entails.

THAT is God's sacred call to you.

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A few years ago, everyone was wondering whether they were called to be an apostle, a prophet, a bishop, a pastor, an evangelist a teacher or whatever....

Seems like everyone was so caught up in what we call the "five-fold" ministry and where their place in that structure was that they didn't give God time to simply move in their lives.

God indeed has some apostles...

He indeed has some prophets...

He indeed has some teachers, evangelists and pastors...

And you may or may not fit into one of those callings, but EVERY Christian is called to one thing: **to hear and obey the voice of the living God.**

You may never start a church in the dusty backwoods of some third-world country.

You may never preach to 10,000 people gathered together in a sacred convocation.

You may never raise someone from the dead...

But God's calling on your life is the same as it is on mine, and on every Christian's life: **hear the voice of the living God and obey.**

## Chapter 2

### Hear and obey

When Jesus was ministering to the people of His day, he said something awesome:

Jesus said to them,

*My Father is always at his work to this very day, and I, too, am working. For this reason the Jews tried all the harder to kill him; not only was he breaking the Sabbath, but he was even calling God his own Father, making himself equal with God. Jesus gave them this answer: I tell you the truth, the Son can do nothing by himself; he can do only what he sees his Father doing, because whatever the Father does the Son also does. For the Father loves the Son and shows him all he does. Yes, to your amazement he will show him even greater things than these. For just as the Father raises the dead and gives them life, even so the Son gives life to whom he is pleased to give it. Moreover, the Father judges no one, but has entrusted all judgment to the Son, that all may honor the Son just as they honor the Father. He who does not honor the Son does not honor the Father, who sent him. I tell you the truth, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life and will not be condemned; he has crossed over from death to life. I tell you the truth, a time is coming and has now come when the dead will hear the voice of the Son of God and those who hear will live.*

*John 5:16-24 NIV*

The claim of Jesus is both profound and essential to our successful operation as Christians.

He claimed that He only did those things He first

saw the Father do.

In other words, He did **nothing** on His own.

Everything He did was what the Father wanted Him to do, He did not question, He did not refuse.

More importantly, however, Jesus DID NOTHING until He first saw the Father do it.

He wasn't just going about His business, changing His plans when God got hold of Him...

He wasn't doing whatever He wanted to do until He got a red-line phone call directive from heaven...

He did NOTHING until He first saw the Father do it!

His entire being...

His entire day, every day...

His waking up...

His eating...

His breathing...

His preaching...

ALL were directed by the Father—the Father who first had done the things Jesus was replicating on the earth!

Remember, partner, Jesus was the perfect antithesis of Adam.

Adam was the chief glorifier of the flesh...

Jesus was the chief glorifier of the Spirit...

Adam succumbed to the temptation to glorify man over God...

Jesus resisted the temptation of the devil to glorify the flesh...

Adam's greatest temptation was the temptation to glorify his own flesh by learning the difference

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between good and evil so that he would no longer have to rely on God to tell him!

Do you see the parallel with Jesus—the converse parallel?

Adam wanted to find a way to please God without relying on Him...

Jesus wanted to please God **BY** relying on Him.

The war between the flesh and the spirit can be defined in the differences between Adam and Jesus.

Adam had complete intimacy with God before the fall of man—he asked God about everything; how to move, what to say, what to think, how to behave...

But the temptation of the devil was so successful because Adam wanted to exalt the flesh—he wanted to know within himself how to please God, how to do right and avoid wrong.

It was a seemingly righteous desire—to those in the flesh.

But to those in the Spirit, it is obvious that Adam's desire to please God through the arm of the flesh was **EXACTLY OPPOSITE OF CHRIST!**

Jesus—who **CLEARLY** knew in Himself how to please God, instead waited until He saw the Father's will before He would act on even the slightest thing!

Partner, do you see the difference?

Adam **had** to rely on God, but wanted to know how to please Him within himself.

Jesus knew how to please the Father within Himself, but instead **wanted** to rely on the Father!

Walking in the Spirit is no secret.

Read that again, partner.

Walking in the Spirit is a simple matter—just hearing and obeying the Spirit.

Read what Jesus said:

*Jesus answered, "I tell you the truth, no one can enter the kingdom of God unless he is born of water and the Spirit. **Flesh gives birth to flesh, but the Spirit gives birth to spirit.** You should not be surprised at my saying, 'You must be born again.' The wind blows wherever it pleases. **You hear its sound, but you cannot tell where it comes from or where it is going.** So it is with everyone born of the Spirit."*

*John 3:5-8 NIV*

Jesus made a profound statement.

Those who are not of the Spirit have no idea what those who are of the Spirit are doing.

I heard a story of a preacher who was riding a bike. As he rode north, the wind blew against him, so he turned east. The wind was blowing against him that way, too. He turned south and the wind was still blowing against him. As he finally turned west, it was no surprise that the wind was blowing against him.

Remembering the verse above, the preacher understood—you can't figure out the wind, because you're not of the wind.

If you're of the Spirit, those of the flesh will not be able to figure you out.

They won't understand because you'll be listening to God and obeying Him—and the things you'll do will be completely foreign to them.

*But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: **for they are foolishness unto him:** neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.*

*1 Corinthians 2:14, KJV*

Why was Jesus so unpopular with the religious



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leaders of His day?

Because they stood for compliance with laws that could justify them through the flesh—Jesus, however, stood for reliance on God, who alone could receive glory for man's obedience.

*When you were dead in your sins and in the uncircumcision of your sinful nature, God made you alive with Christ. He forgave us all our sins, **having canceled the written code**, with its regulations, that was against us and that stood opposed to us; he took it away, nailing it to the cross. And having disarmed the powers and authorities, he made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them by the cross. Therefore do not let anyone judge you by what you eat or drink, or with regard to a religious festival, a New Moon celebration or a Sabbath day. These are a shadow of the things that were to come; the reality, however, is found in Christ. Do not let anyone who delights in false humility and the worship of angels disqualify you for the prize. Such a person goes into great detail about what he has seen, and his unspiritual mind puffs him up with idle notions. He has lost connection with the Head, from whom the whole body, supported and held together by its ligaments and sinews, grows as God causes it to grow. Since you died with Christ to the basic principles of this world, why, as though you still belonged to it, do you submit to its rules: "Do not handle! Do not taste! Do not touch!"? These are all destined to perish with use, because they are based on human commands and teachings. Such regulations indeed have an appearance of wisdom, with their self-imposed worship, their false humility and their harsh treatment of the body, but they lack any value in restraining sensual indulgence.*

*Colossians 2:13-23 NIV*

The authorities and principalities who ruled under the ordinances of the Old Covenant hated

Jesus because He threatened their monopoly over the lives of those who followed them.

They, by their understanding and interpretation of the statutes, were able to become gods of sorts to the people beneath them—and they were able to receive glory and adoration for their keeping of the ordinances.

But Jesus, triumphing over them in the very ordinances they so gloried in, was able to, by giving ALL THE GLORY TO THE FATHER, make a show of them openly—and then to nail the ordinances to the cross, forever ending their oppressive rule over the lives of the people!

Partner, I don't know if you understand the tremendous significance of those two paragraphs...

If you're able to stand it, read them again.

Jesus was able to give the glory to the Father because HE FIRST SAW THE FATHER DO **EVERYTHING** HE DID HIMSELF!

Pay close attention, partner, because this will change your entire Christian life.

You want God to move in your life, here's the key.

You want to make an impact for God on the nations of the world—here is the key!

Letting the Spirit control you is the key to acting on God's will.

Partner, we're all, as Christians, in the same boat—we all want to please God. The only thing that matters is WHAT METHOD we choose to please God.

If we choose to follow Adam's method—or the method of the Pharisees and Sadducees—we will find ourselves being lauded by many people around the world as righteous.

We'll find all sorts of religious people giving us

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praise for our charitable works, for our outreaches, our kindness and our helping of people from all walks of life.

But when we find ourselves standing in glory before the judgment seat, we'll find God has an entirely different view of us.

If we choose to follow Christ's method of pleasing God, we'll find many people in the world will greatly dislike us—especially religious leaders—and they'll view us as quirky and on the fringes of Christianity.

But when we get to glory...

Oh, partner...

When we get to glory, we'll find God has an ENTIRELY DIFFERENT VIEW of us!

Partner, when you follow the Spirit, you'll find your greatest critics will come from inside Christianity.

Let me repeat that.

Some of your most ardent opponents will come from inside the so-called church, and they will call themselves Christians.

*Watch out for false prophets. They come to you **in sheep's clothing**, but inwardly they are ferocious wolves. By their fruit you will recognize them. Do people pick grapes from thornbushes, or figs from thistles? Likewise every good tree bears good fruit, but a bad tree bears bad fruit. A good tree cannot bear bad fruit, and a bad tree cannot bear good fruit. Every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire. Thus, by their fruit you will recognize them. **"Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only he who does the will of my Father who is in heaven. Many will say to me on that day, 'Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in***

***your name, and in your name drive out demons and perform many miracles?*** ' Then I will tell them plainly, 'I never knew you. Away from me, you evildoers!'

*Matthew 7:15-23 NIV*

These people are wearing sheep's clothing—meaning they appear to be Christians.

Not only do they appear to be Christians, they call Jesus "Lord!"

Not only do they call Him Lord, they cast out demons in His name, they prophesy in His name, they perform "many miracles" in His name!

Partner, some of the greatest critics of the Spirit-led life are those who call themselves Christians but are really ravenous wolves, only desiring to devour you!

They criticize those who are led by the Spirit because they themselves are not led by the Spirit—even though they claim to live the Spirit-led life.

This is a fundamental point to understand:

*If the world hates you, **keep in mind that it hated me first.** If you belonged to the world, it would love you as its own. As it is, you do not belong to the world, but I have chosen you out of the world. That is why the world hates you. Remember the words I spoke to you: 'No servant is greater than his master.' **If they persecuted me, they will persecute you also.** If they obeyed my teaching, they will obey yours also.*

*John 15:18-20 NIV*

Partner, ask yourself this question: who persecuted Jesus?

The sinners (those who had no religious affiliation) loved Jesus because He offered them hope and salvation.

*Hear and obey*

It was the religious leaders who persecuted Jesus—those who had something to lose by taking the emphasis off the flesh and putting it on the Spirit.

*They will put you out of the synagogue; in fact, a time is coming when anyone who kills you will think he is offering a service to God. They will do such things because they have not known the Father or me.*

*John 16:2-3 NIV*

Those who are of the Spirit confuse those of the flesh because they have not known the Father, and they don't know Jesus.

As they persecute you, they believe they'll be doing it in the name of Christ!

Partner, that's happening today, as entire ministries are set up with the purpose of persecuting the move of the Spirit in the name of Christ.

But that's because they neither know God nor understand His moving.

That may sound harsh, but Jesus said it—not I.

If you want God to use you, you should be ready to endure the persecution of "Christians" who tell you you've gone off the deep end.



## Chapter 3

### Preparing Yourself

How do you get ready for the Spirit to use you?

This chapter could end with a two-word sentence: Give up.

A preacher one time said something profound: "The key to Christianity is this: relax. You've got nothing."

That's the simplest distillation of this saying by Jesus:

*Greater love has no one than this, that he lay down his life for his friends. **You are my friends if you do what I command.***

*John 15:13-14 NIV*

Being in the Spirit simply means hearing what God wants and then doing it.

You have no greater love for Jesus than if you're willing to lay down your life for Him—not even talking about being martyred. Instead, by "laying down your life," I mean being willing to completely give your life over to Him and let Him be your source, your guide, your leader.

Read the part of that scripture that's bolded: You are my friends if you do what I command.

Not what he "commanded," but what he commands—alive, right now, in this day and time, to you day in and day out!

You are His friend if you listen and obey!

Jesus said that those who worship the Father must worship Him in Spirit and in truth.

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Did you ever wonder what that meant?

Did you ever wonder if that meant a certain, special way of worshiping the Father, if you just raised your hands high enough or if you just really meant it enough?

Did you ever see someone worshiping God during the worship service and think, "that person is worshiping in Spirit and truth?"

That's not what Jesus is talking about. When He says to worship the Father in Spirit and in truth, He means for you to be IN THE SPIRIT! He means for you to let the Holy Ghost take over every aspect of your life!

*If you love me, you will obey what I command. And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Counselor to be with you forever—the Spirit of truth.*

*The world cannot accept him, because it neither sees him nor knows him. But you know him, for he lives **with** you and will be **in** you. I will not leave you as orphans; I will come to you.*

*John 14:15-18 NIV*

Jesus' promise to you is that you will be a worshiper in Spirit and in truth because the Spirit, who was WITH you, would now be IN you!

The world can't accept Him because it can't see Him and doesn't know Him.

Remember, the wind blows wherever it wants, and those who are not of the wind can't seem to figure it out!

Those who aren't of the Spirit can't figure out anything about the Spirit!

But Jesus promised that those who are in the Spirit would be comforted by the Spirit!



## *Preparing Yourself*

Read on, partner, this is one of the most precious promises of the Bible:

*But the Counselor, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you.*

*John 14:26 NIV*

Oh, partner!

Remember, we've been talking about how Jesus pleased the Father because He only did what He first saw the Father do!

We've been talking about how He did not live according to how He knew to please God, but instead depended on the Father Himself to tell Him how to live!

And now Jesus promises that the Holy Spirit will do the SAME THING FOR US!

And on top of that, the Spirit doesn't rely on us for ANYTHING! He alone is capable of making us live "in the Spirit!"

*Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid.*

*John 14:27 NIV*

Jesus leaves us peace because we no longer have to struggle with our own understanding in order to please God!

We no longer have to think about how we can please God!

We no longer have to think about ways to be sure we're doing what's right!

We no longer have to study the rules and regulations, hoping we haven't somewhere overlooked one small rule, one tiny regulation...

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We can now do just as Jesus did, relaxing, laying back and following the living God because the Spirit He sent to do the job in us is doing the hard work for us!

A popular catch phrase these days is "What would Jesus do?"

My answer to that is simple: Jesus would SEE WHAT THE FATHER IS DOING AND HE WOULD DO THE SAME!

Instead of trying to figure out what Jesus would do, those who live in the Spirit can simply go TO THE SAME SOURCE HE WENT TO!

What would Jesus do?

He would relax and depend on the Holy Ghost, doing only those things that someone living a Spirit-led life would do!

You want to prophesy before kings as Jeremiah did?

You want God to use you as He's never used you before?

You want to be a mighty man or woman of power for God?

The answer is simple—relax, you've got nothing. Let the Holy Spirit do His job!

Winning the lost is the number one goal of this ministry.

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Dr. Cerullo has also authored more than 160 books. Few ministers have had such an impact on the destiny of the nations of the world. Morris Cerullo's life has been sacrificially dedicated to training and spiritually equipping pastors, lay-people and evangelists to reach their nations for Christ with a supernatural endowment of God's Power.
